- participating in arts activities
- researching artists and their work
- sharing their arts discoveries

There are 3 parts to Arts Award

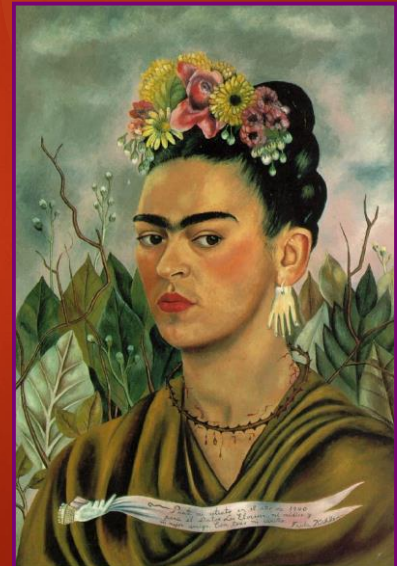
Discover: Part A

- ▶ In part A you research many different types of art and take part in one arts activity. This could be a class outside school or even just an art lesson in school! This will be recorded in your arts log provided by school.



Part B

- ▶ In Part B you research your favourite artist. They could be a painter, singer, actor, anyone who works in the arts.



Part C

- ▶ In Part C you share you work with someone who hasn't been involved in your project.



The end of the project

- ▶ At the end of the project you will receive a certificate. It will also allow you to partake in the next level of Arts Award.
- ▶ A letter will be going out to your parents this week. If this sounds like something you would be interested in then make sure you send back the reply.
- ▶ Some children started this in Year 2 and can use that work to complete the award this year.
