

These are words which are not completely decodable – either because they contain a GPC which has not yet been introduced, or because they contain a 'tricky' GPC that does not follow the general rules. They are also known as Common Exception Words (CEWs). Children should be encouraged to work out the decodable parts (if any) of Red Words before being supported with the 'tricky' GPC.
